TAX SEASON INFORMATION

Tax season is here! Please see our website for the Sass Accounting Tax Season Schedulewww.sassaccounting.com. If you haven't already, be sure to call and schedule your appointment early as we are filling up fast!



Some things to keep in mind when making your appointment: ~If you cancel your appointment less than 24 hours in advance, you will receive a \$37.50 "No Show" fee.

- \sim If you drop off taxes or contact us to make your appointment after 2/28/14 (Corporate taxes) or 3/31/14 (personal taxes), you will be assessed a \$37.50 late fee, or receive an automatic extension at our discretion.
- ~1120/1120S corporations- your tax returns are due 3/15/14.

TODAY'S TAX TIP

Over the past few years, the IRS has found the 90% of all **e-filed** tax returns were received within 10-21 days after filing. This time frame does not apply to returns that are mailed to the IRS.

If you would like to check the status of your return, you may go to the Where's My Refund section of the IRS website. In order to use this website, you must follow the following rules:

- You must wait 72 hours after you e-file or 4 weeks if you mail in your return
- You need to have available your social security number, your filing status and the exact amount your return showed you would be refunded

Please keep in mind that the projected refund date may change as your return is moved through the system.

You can also check the status of your Wisconsin refund at the Wisconsin Department of Revenue website page, <u>Refund Inquiry State</u> or the new DOR mobile app. The WI Revenue mobile app allows you to use a number of their popular tax-related online services found on their website, such as: Refund look-up, estimated tax payment status, updates & more.
